***Eligibility for broodmare residency shall be achieved by meeting at least one of the following rules:
(Residency requirements are documented with pre and post foal inspections.)

- 1. Thirty days' residency until the foal is inspected by a department inspector, if in foal to a Registered Iowa Stallion.
2. Thirty days' residency until the foal is inspected by a department inspector, for broodmares which are bred back to Iowa registered stallions.
3. Thoroughbred mares; Continuous residency from December 15 until the foal is inspected by a department inspector if the mare was bred by other than an Iowa registered stallion and which is not bred back to an Iowa registered stallion.
4. Quarter Horse and Standardbred mares; Continuous residency from January 31 until the foal is inspected by a department inspector if the mare was bred by other than an Iowa registered stallion and which is not bred back to an Iowa registered stallion.

The one-time broodmare registration will cover the mare her entire productive life as long as there is not a change of ownership (at which time a mare transfer form must be completed) and she meets the aforementioned eligibility rules.

21—62.37(99D) Embryo transfer for Iowa-foaled status.

62.37(1) The recipient mare must be in the state of Iowa before the first day of December, the year prior to foaling and must meet all the required Iowa rules, remain in Iowa until the foal or foals are born, and are inspected by the department.

62.37(3) Registration and status reports of recipient mares and donor mares must be submitted to the department with proper identification, including but not limited to registration certificates, brands, and identification numbers.

62.37(4) Recipient mares must have a name, brand, or some means of identification and must be photographed for inspection purposes.
